

Ministry Worker – 0.4 FTE Busselton Baptist Community Church (BBC)

About us

Located 2.5 hours south west of Perth, Busselton is situated on the beautiful Geographe Bay. We're on a **mission** to make mature disciples of Jesus in ever-increasing number worldwide - for the glory of God and the love of others. And we have a **vision** to be a fruitful church - focused on growing and planting services and churches with a passion for sending disciples near and far! We're looking for gospel workers who love Jesus and are innovative, organised, collaborative and passionate about equipping all God's people for the work of ministry.

The Role:

Area Leader - Belongs in Community

To bring into reality the vision and mission of BBC through leadership and collaboration with others in promoting discipleship growth across all areas of Church life in the "Belongs in Community" Area. This position will provide direction and oversight on all activities within the "Belongs in Community" area, including (but not limited to) collaborating with the leadership team, facilitation of event organisation, overseeing newcomer integration and collecting and analysing key metrics.

Focus Leader - Kids

The Kids Focus Leader will be responsible for promoting discipleship growth with intentional awareness of children's mission and maturity needs. This includes working with and supporting the various Ministry Leaders involved in Children's Ministry and working in collaboration with the various Area Leaders to facilitate outcomes consistent with BBC's vision and mission.

Successful applicants will be required to participate in the wider life of the Church, including committed attendance to Sunday Gatherings and active involvement in church life events. They must also have the capacity to build positive and effective relationships with a broad range of people, pursuing the vision and mission of the church.

Essential criteria for this role:

- BBC is Safe Church Organisation, all staff are required to comply with the applicable Child Safe legislation and ensure that the Church's safe church policies and procedures are implemented at all times.
- All employees must have a valid Working with Children Check and National Police clearance.
- Active and committed to the Christian faith and be able to demonstrate spiritual maturity and integrity.
- Have been baptised as a believer by full immersion, or willing to be.
- Acknowledge and uphold BBC's theological position as outlined in the Constitution & Statement of Faith.
- Relevant, recognised qualifications from a theological institution, or enrolled & working towards completion.
- At least 5 years' experience in church ministry leadership and in children's ministry.
- Be a team builder, fostering collaboration and commitment across all levels within the Church community.
- Exercise leadership with integrity, loyalty and honesty.
- Well-developed written, organisational and communication skills.
